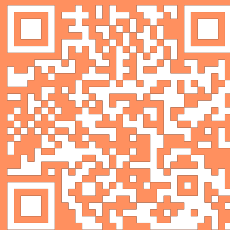

Find free naloxone.

Know how to use naloxone.



- Call 911
- Place in their nose.
- Press down to release.
- Wait for 2 minutes.
- Repeat once if needed in alternate nostril.

Bring naloxone anywhere you go.



The goal of administering naloxone is to restore breathing, not consciousness, and usually no more than 1-4 doses are needed.
