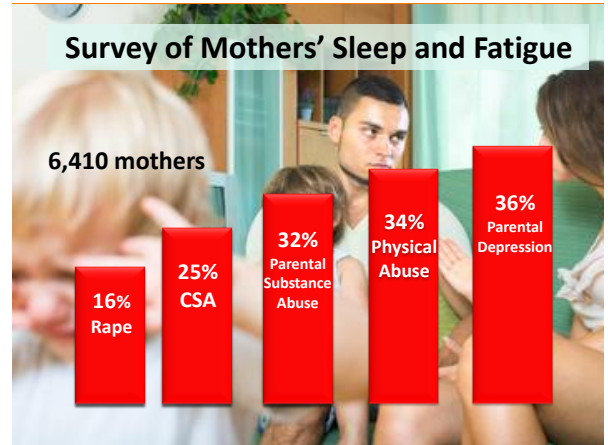
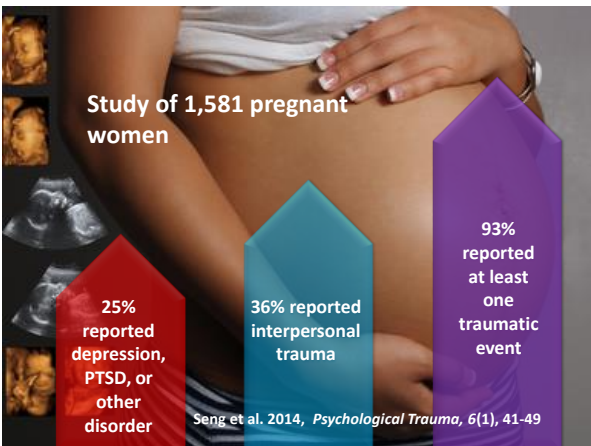
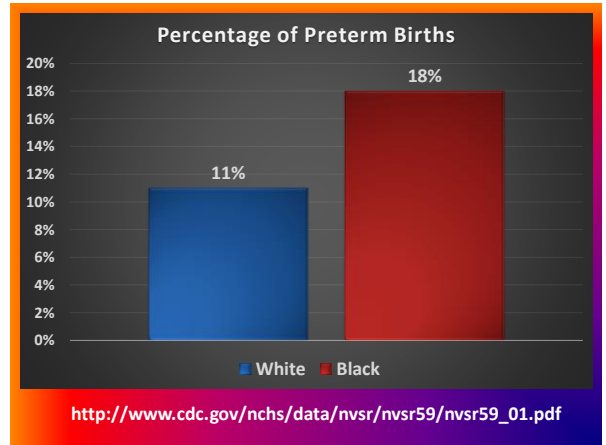
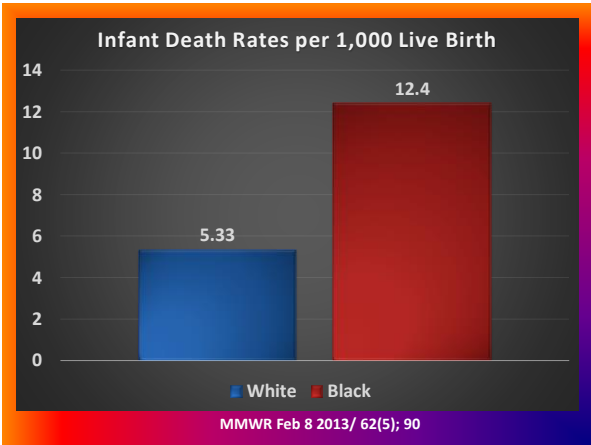




- Child Maltreatment**  
*CSA, CPA, CEA, Neglect*
- Parental Impairment**  
*Substance abuse, mental illness, partner violence, criminal activity*
- Parental Loss**  
*Death or divorce*
- Low Socioeconomic Status**  
*Community violence, unsafe housing, food insecurity, medical care*


- **Perceived discrimination**
  - You are treated with less courtesy other people
  - You are treated with less respect than other people
  - You receive poorer service than other people at restaurants and stores
  - People act as if they think you are not smart

- **Low social status related to vascular inflammation**
  - ET-1, sICAM
- **Independent of hypertension status or ethnicity**

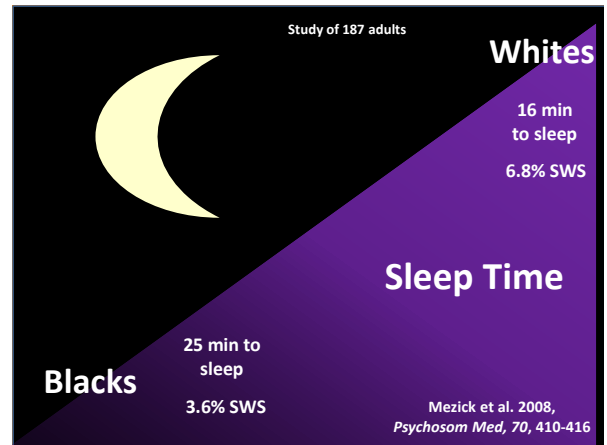

- Higher glucose
- Greater insulin resistance
- Higher-LDL, lower HDL
- Higher waist circumference
- Higher BMI

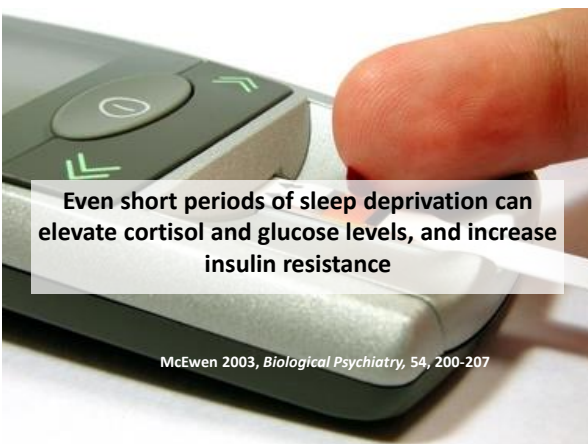

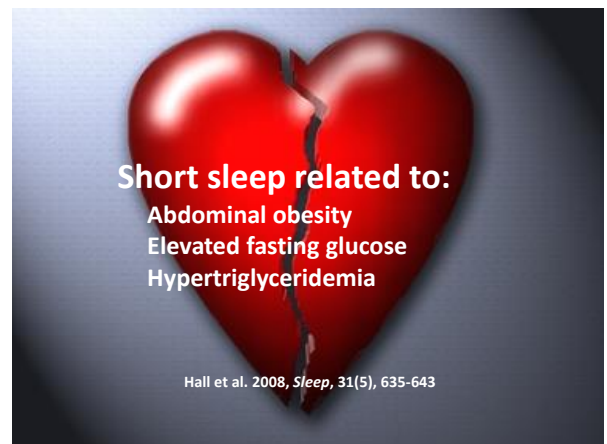

**Even short periods of sleep deprivation can elevate cortisol and glucose levels, and increase insulin resistance**

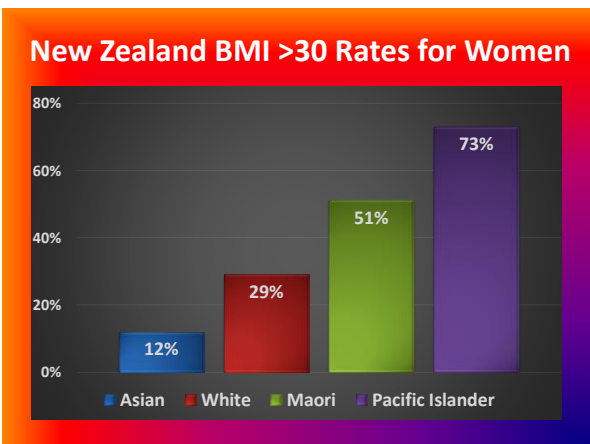
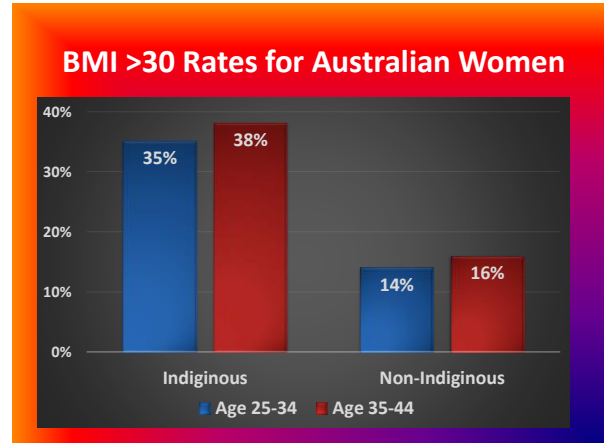
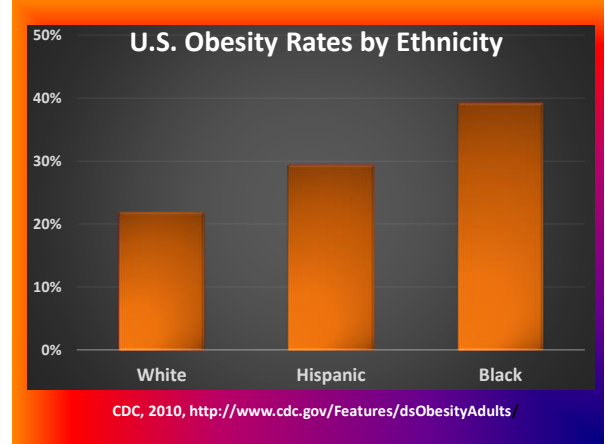

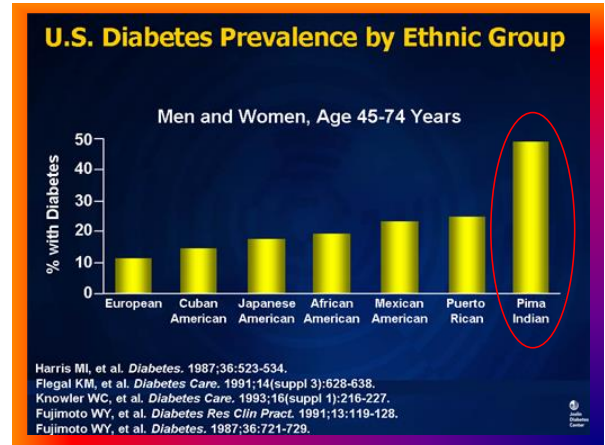
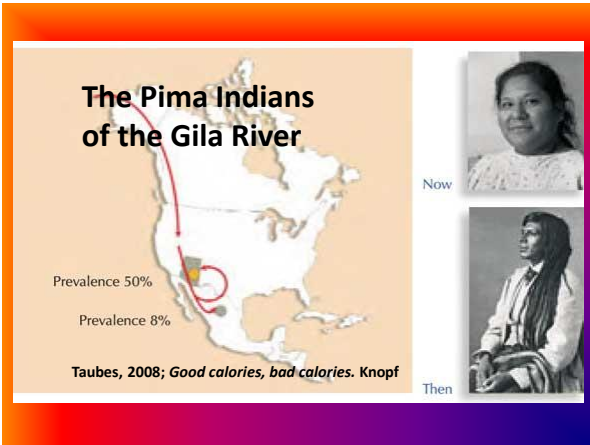
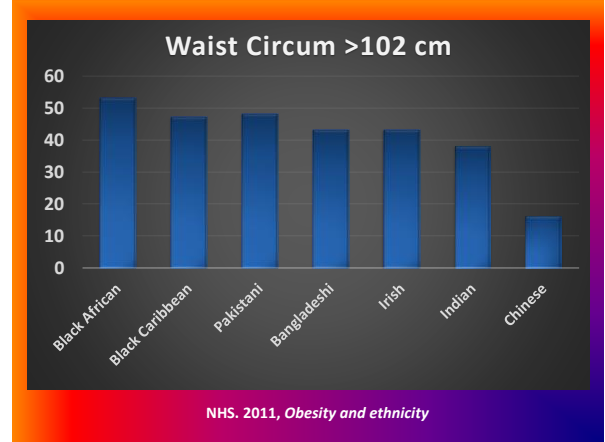
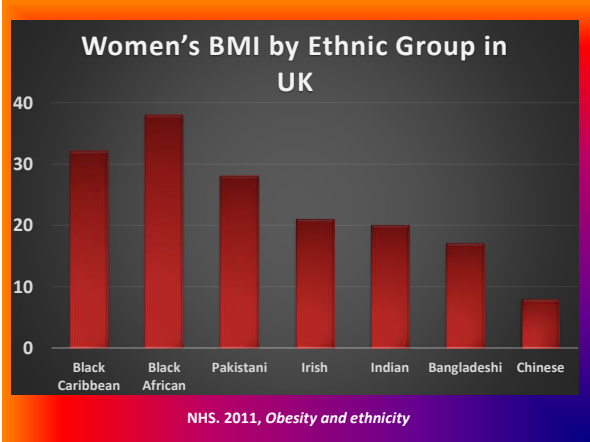


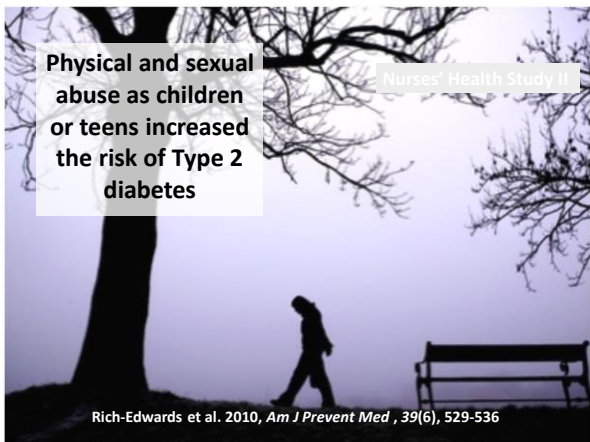
**Short sleep related to:**

- 69% increase for repeated forced sex

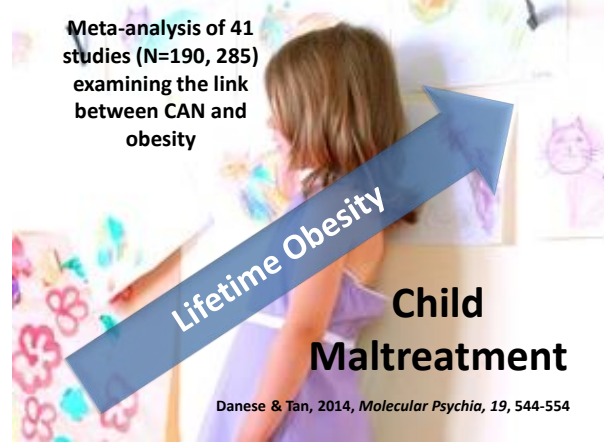
