Aurora, IL DuPage & Kane Counties Kendall & Will Counties Population: 197,899	Section 42-129 Liquor, wine, or beer advertisements are prohibited on benches throughout the city.

South Holland, IL Cook County Population: 22,030	Section 3-31 Alcohol and tobacco advertisements are prohibited on transportation shelters.
Eureka, IL Woodford County Population: 5,295	Section 6-70 Off-premise alcohol signage restrictions.
Wheeling, IL Cook and Lake Counties Population: 37,648	Chapter 21.07.020 Packaged liquor, restaurant, and tavern window and signage restrictions.
Morrison, IL Whiteside County Population: 4,188	Section 4-112 Interior view requirements and lighting requirements.
DeKalb County, IL Population: 105,160	Section 6-23 Beer and wine advertising restrictions on gasoline islands. Restrictions on signage on buildings, windows, or within five feet of any window.
