Waukegan, IL Lake County Population: 88,826	Section 3-50 Definitions provided as well as conduct prohibited. Fees and penalties identified with language included on penalty and fee adjustments made annually.
Barrington, IL Lake County Population: 10,327	Section 3-3-16 Underage persons; social hosting regulations. Definitions provided. Section C provides information on specific restrictions and prohibitions.
Skokie, IL Cook County Population: 64,784	Section 10-7 Liability for permitting minors to possess or consume alcoholic liquor.
Metamora, IL Woodford County Population: 3,636	Section 9.36 Definitions provided. Regulation of social hosting and language involving response costs.
Round Lake Park, IL Lake County, IL Population: 7,505	Section 139.07 Social hosting responsibilities and requirement. Language included for civil liability for negligence.

Burnham, IL Cook County Population: 4,206	Section 6-18 Responsibility of parents and others for alcohol consumption by minors. Includes language of intentionally, knowingly, negligently, and recklessly.
Villa Park, IL DuPage County Population: 21,800	Section 3-415 Parental responsibility for consumption of alcoholic liquor by minors.
Zion, IL Lake County Population: 24,413	Section 62-230 Social hosting liability. Includes language defining residence or premises and reasonable steps. Includes language for an amnesty provision if host/owner calls police for help before anyone else does or terminates the event upon learning of alcohol usage.
Buffalo Grove, IL Lake and Cook Counties Population: 41,496	Section 5.20.192 Social hosting responsibility. Definition of reasonable steps as well as language for civil liability.
Pekin, IL Tazewell County Population: 34,094	Section 6-2-9-6 Found under Chapter 2 – Offenses/misdemeanor code. Includes Social host responsibility and prohibited conduct and responsibilities of persons host an event or gathering.
