QUESTION	ANSWER
<p><i>Please revisit the 10% budget variance & when to re-budget</i></p>	<p>Within any line item in your budget, expenditures can be over by 10% or \$1,000, whichever is greater, but not more. This implies that other line items will be less than 100% of what was budgeted since the overall contract amount cannot change.</p>
<p><i>Our organization will not consider the contract executed until we get a fully executed contract from the CSA before we can start services. Can you provide any estimated time line between the time we submit and an executed agreement posted on CSA?</i></p>	<p>IDHS OCA is responsible for publishing executed contracts. Since these are grants, a provider signed contract that is submitted to OCA is considered executed but I understand that Universities have their own policy regarding executed contracts. It usually takes OCA between 6 to 12 weeks. I have asked OCA for a statement regarding the above and will distribute once I receive it.</p>
<p><i>For the promo materials and prior notification - can you tell us a little more about what the expectations are for this for the SRSAPS grants?</i></p>	<p>Please refer to the guidance that Shantel provided prior.</p>
<p><i>Our signature page was not signed by Rafael or anyone else -- was that the final version that our ED signed?</i></p>	<p>IDHS OCA is responsible for publishing executed contracts, signed by the organization and IDHS representative. Since these are grants, a provider signed contract that is submitted to OCA is considered executed. Work can commence on the contract start date of July 1 even before a fully executed contract (both signatures) is available for download.</p>
