QUESTION	ANSWER
<i>Is the IYS recruitment plan for our service areas or for the IYS universe?</i>	<b>The IYS recruitment plan for FY19 is for the IYS universe. Service area is the geographic area in FY18 you were approved to serve by DHS. Your service area may be specific townships, counties, cities or towns. Your IYS Universe is all the eligible IYS public schools (schools having 8<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup> or 12<sup>th</sup> grade) within your approved service area.</b>
<i>Does the Botvin's LifeSkills and Too Good for Drugs for High School need to have a core and booster?</i>	<b>Too Good For Drugs (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>) is 10 sessions-core only no booster sessions and Botvin's LifeSkills (9<sup>th</sup>-10<sup>th</sup>) is also 10 sessions-core only no boosters.</b>
<i>Do meeting minutes from Youth Advisory Committee for FY18 need to be uploaded or is that a new requirement for FY19?</i>	<b>YAC meeting minutes are required for FY18 and FY19 to be uploaded into the Hub. This is not a new requirement for FY19.</b>
<i>If TGFD is approved for HS, is 9th grade considered a booster year or core year? Should we only be implementing TGFD in high schools where they've already had TGFD in middle school?</i>	<b>Too Good For Drugs (9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>) is 10 sessions-core only no booster sessions. It is not required the youth have TGFD in the middle school. You can implement it solely in the 9<sup>th</sup> grade if you choose. The Model Program Chart on the Prevention First website outline Model Program requirements.</b>
<i>Effective FY2019, 5th Grade is NO longer an approved grade for YPE implementation. Now, we have to deliver TGFD for 6th Grade (CORE) and 7th Grade (BOOSTER)... Question... who do we contact to make changes?</i>	<b>Please notify DHS and Jo Pauly with CPRD via email of the changes so we may update the Hub with the current information.</b>
<i>Is the Model Program Curricula training only for those who are implementing a new curricula?</i>	<b>It is preferable that those who are attending Model program curricula are implementing it however, if you are considering a change and want training you may attend. Supervisors may also want to attend to learn more about the curricula.</b>
<i>MEPV replacing the EDF?</i>	<b>Yes, MEPV (Monthly Expenditure Payment Voucher) has replaced what was previously referred to as EDF (Expenditure Documentation Form) starting in SFY2018.</b>

*Is there an annual financial report and is that completed in CSA? Just needing to clarify. Is this still due by Aug 6, 2018?*

**I believe the question is referencing two different forms and due dates. One is the GRRF (Grant Reconciliation Recovery Form) and the other is the monthly MEVP.**

**The June MEVP (Monthly Expenditure Voucher Payment) was due by August 6, 2018. This was to be submitted via email to SAPP Program Administrator Shantel High.**

**The Annual Grant Reconciliation Recovery forms are due and to be uploaded in the CRV by Aug 15 as long as there is no payback. If there is a payback then forms must be mailed to the attention of Carroll Benedict, 222 S College, Springfield, IL 62704. If any questions you may contact Carroll at 217/557-6618.**

**In addition, due to ongoing GATA implementation, there will be a SUPR close out report that will need to be submitted. Information regarding this form is forthcoming.**
